Throughout December, we have completed 2016 SATs papers in class. These were administered under test conditions. We analysed the papers with the children and gave them time to edit and learn from their errors.

We will be doing another full set (2017 SATs papers) at the end of January.

Below is your child's current attainment. Please bear in mind that these only show your child's attainment from test scores on one day. Teacher assessments have also taken place and these will differ slightly (often higher) from the test scores.
