Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 4 — Swimming Lessons — Spring Term 2017

As part of their physical education programme each Year 4 class will have swimming lessons once a week for ten weeks at SplashPoint during the Spring term. We will begin swimming lessons on Monday 9th January 2017 between 10.00am and 12.00 noon on the following dates:

9th January 2017 – 13th February 2017 6 weeks 6th March 2017 – 27th March 2017 4 weeks

When completing the permission slip attached, please indicate an approximate level of swimming ability. This will only be used as an initial guide as all children will be assessed by staff at SplashPoint. Each group (half class) will be in the water for half an hour, with tuition by two ASA qualified teachers.

The cost for these ten sessions will be £27.00 per child which includes a swimming hat and transport to and from SplashPoint by coach. If you would prefer, you can spread the cost of this activity as regular instalments. A payment card will be issued upon your first instalment. We appreciate that some families might find it difficult to contribute all or part of the suggested sum and if you feel that you are in such a position, please do not hesitate to speak to one of us or the Head Teacher, in confidence, to discuss whether some suitable arrangements can be made to cover the cost of your child's participation. All children will be included in the activity. If your child currently receives / has received Free School Meals or is a "services" or "Looked After" child we do not require a contribution. If you think that your child may be eligible for FSM please speak to a member of staff in the office.

As usual there is an option for you pay by cash or cheque. Please ensure it is clearly labelled with your child's name and class, in a sealed envelope.

Please can I ask that all permission slips and payments are returned by Monday 6th December 2016.

Children will need to have appropriate swimwear which should be a one piece swimsuit for girls and short, not baggy, trunks for boys. Goggles are advisable. SplashPoint has made the use of swimming caps compulsory for all school swimming lessons. These have been purchased in bulk by the school and will be issued at their first session.
