## London Trip – Friday 15<sup>th</sup>June 2018

As part of our current topic we are pleased to inform you that we have arranged a visit to London. The children will be visiting the Houses of Parliament and taking part in an exciting workshop. They will also be taking a ride on the London Eye and enjoying a Thames River Boat cruise.

Friends of Heene Primary School are very kindly subsidising the cost of this trip, which without them would be double the cost. We would therefore ask you to make a voluntary contribution of £15.00 to cover the cost of this visit. Although we are able to subsidise trips to some degree, unless those parents who are able make a contribution do so, it is probable that these visits could not take place. We appreciate that some families might find it difficult to contribute all or part of the suggested sum and, if you feel that you are in such a position, please do not hesitate to speak to one of us or the Head Teacher, in confidence regarding your child's participation. <u>All</u> children will be included in the visit.

We will travel by coach and leave school at **<u>6.30am</u>** so please ensure that your child is in on time, preferably **6.15am** to be registered – we cannot wait for anyone! We need to leave at this time so that we are able to travel to London and complete all the activities. We will arrive back at school at approximately 6.30pm.

## Medicines Note: If your child needs travel sickness medication during the trip please ask the office for a consent form. We cannot give your child the medicine if you do not complete this form.

Your child needs to wear full school uniform, sensible school shoes and bring a suitable coat. In addition to a packed lunch please bring a couple of bottles of water (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks) and some extra snacks as this is a long day. Please ensure your child brings a 'back pack' style bag as the children need their hands free. Those children entitled to a FSM will receive a packed lunch, unless you indicate on the consent form that you would like to provide your own. If you pay for hot school meals please do not book one for Friday 15<sup>th</sup> June 2018. The children should <u>NOT</u> bring a mobile phone or any money with them BUT can bring their own camera (it is their responsibility).
