We are very excited to share the news with you that the Hands on History Company, who bring The Stone Age alive to children, will be visiting Year 3 on Tuesday 13th June 2017.

During their visit they will show different types of clothes that the Prehistoric people wore, explain how they made and used weapons and tools as well as how they made fire! It will be an exciting day for the children as we delve deeper into our Stone Age topic with a 'hands on' experience for all of Year 3!

We ask you to make a voluntary contribution of £10.00 to cover the cost of this visit.
