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


<u>ALLOTMENT PROJECT</u> - Prior to half term Neil Ambrose (Edie Sellwood's dad) met with AJ (Premises Officer) to discuss our allotment area following the announcement of our Tesco 'BAGS OF HELP' money. <u>ATTENDANCE / PUNCTUALITY</u> — The School day starts at 8.50am, therefore the gates/doors will be opened at 8.40am and closed at 8.50am. Teachers will take registers at 8.50am so any children who arrive after 8.50am will miss the register and be recorded as late. The registers will remain open until 9.20am. Any child arriving after 9.20am will be recorded as an unauthorised absence. Lateness is still an issue for some children. Mrs Turnbull (Admissions Officer) and I meet regularly to review attendance and do contact some parents to highlight lower than expected attendance percentages or punctuality issues.

<u>P.E. KIT</u> — Please ensure that your child has their full P.E. kit in school every day, including waterproof trainers, as half of their P.E. lessons take place outdoors and sometimes across in the park. If your child does not have their P.E. kit in school, they will miss out on their lesson. Shorts, joggers and P.E. t-shirts can be purchased from the school office. It is advisable that children do have a warm tracksuit for the colder, wetter weather. There were too many children last week who did not have the appropriate kit in school following the Easter holidays!

**P.E. Kit Alert! Following the introduction of Houses this year we are introducing PE t-shirts in house colours. These will be available to purchase during this half term in readiness for September. This is not compulsory at present for existing Heene children but will be a requirement when you need a new one.

<u>WARMER WEATHER</u> — A few reminders as we hopefully approach warmer weather. It is very important that your child has a sun hat, extra drinks & sun cream with them in hot weather. There are sun creams available that last all day. Sun cream should be applied at home before school and if you feel necessary brought to school clearly labelled with your child's name and class. The sun cream must be handed over to your child's class teacher where it will be kept in the classroom. Sun cream must not be kept in children's book bags or trays as it can leak. PLEASE NOTE THAT STAFF ARE <u>NOT ALLOWED</u> TO ADMINISTER SUN CREAM - YOUR CHILD SHOULD BE ABLE TO APPLY IT THEMSELVES. Also a general reminder - please ensure all items of school uniform are named clearly as in warmer weather they are often discarded on the playground!





Julia Donaldson at Heene Primary

On Thursday 22nd June we are very excited to remind you that the world-famous best-selling children's writer, Julia Donaldson, is coming to Heene Primary.



Julia will be working with some of the classes in **Year 3** using drama and music. After school, when Julia finishes her workshops, Julia's local bookshop, The Steyning Bookshop, will set up a 'pop-up bookshop' in the school hall, selling all Julia's wonderful picture, chapter and song books.

This is a chance for parents and children from all year groups to buy a book and get it signed by Julia.



Julia Donaldson is most well-known for her classic picture book 'The Gruffalo' but in fact she has written over 150 books for children of all ages.

Julia began her writing career as a songwriter, penning jolly songs for children's television. It wasn't until 1993 that her first picture book was published.

After many years in Scotland, Julia now lives in West Sussex with her husband Malcolm, who'll be coming along with his guitar to help out with the workshops.

The Steyning Bookshop will have all Julia's books on sale: Prices start at £4.99 for an 'Early Reader' chapter book, most picture books cost £6.99, and hardbacks from £10.99 including Julia's very latest book 'The Giant Jumperee' which is just out in hardback at £12.99.

We will accept payment by cash, cheque or card, and will give the school back a credit on the book sales to spend on books for the school.

The Steyning Bookshop regret that you may not bring your Julia Donaldson books from home to get signed, as it causes confusion and holds up the queue for those buying on the day.


If you are unable to come to the after-school book sale and signing on the 22nd, but want to buy a book and get it signed / dedicated to your child by Julia, you can pre-order using The Steyning Bookshop's online store.

When placing your order you must add your CHILD'S NAME AND CLASS, and 'HEENE PRIMARY EVENT' and ANY NAME YOU'D LIKE THE BOOK DEDICATED TO (eg 'to James, Happy 8th Birthday') in the 'ORDER NOTES' section of your shopping basket.

Although our website automatically adds a postage charge, we will cancel this from your Paypal payment, and bring your books along to the school on the day, where we will leave the signed books with school staff for you to collect when it suits you.

Website payment is by PAYPAL only. Orders must be placed by Tuesday 20th June.
