Mrs MacGovern and I attended a meeting last night regarding a Year 5 project for next year but were delighted to be offered the late opportunity to slot in a group this year due to another school pulling out. We can take 12 of our Year 5 children over a 3-week period.

The project will take place on Monday afternoons (18th June, 25th June, 9th July) from 1pm – 3pm. Children will be transported to and from the project in the Hospice minibus, accompanied by 2 members of staff from Heene. The children should return by 3.20pm each week. Parents are also invited to join the group on the 9th July for a celebration of their work and a chance to meet the children's buddies!

The project will involve the children being buddied up with one of the patients in the Day Hospice only; taking part in art activities; a tour of the hospice and finding out more about the care that is provided by the hospice to the community.

The aims of the project set out by St Barnabas are:

- Building links and raising awareness in the community about the hospice' work.
- Working with children in the hospice environment to create healthier attitudes towards death, dying and life transition.
- Addressing myths and reducing anxiety around loss and bereavement.
- Lots of fun and lots of laughter!
