## YEAR 6 National Science Museum and Natural History Museum Visit

Welcome back to the new academic year!

To enhance our first Year 6 topic – 'EXTREME EARTH' we will be taking the children to the National Science Museum and Natural History Museum in London on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2018.

We will be travelling by coach to and from school meaning there will be very limited walking in London as the coach will drop us directly outside the museums.

The visit will be an opportunity for children to learn about Natural Disasters through the museum workshops but also will cover some learning from later in the year. In this way the visit will engage children themes and hopefully excite them to want to learn more.

The cost of the visit is  $\pm$  11.35 per child; this includes workshops at the museum and travel. They will not need any additional spending money as we will not be visiting the shop. Children will require a packed lunch on the day of the visit and an extra drink. We will provide additional snacks for them.

More details of the timings for the trip will follow but the likely arrival time back at school on the Thursday is around 6pm. Children will need to be in school by 8.30am in order to be ready to board the coach promptly.
