Design Brief: To design and make a Christmas Decoration

Functional Considerations: Your decoration needs to be able to hang on a Christmas tree.

Aesthetic Considerations: It needs to look appealing on the tree.



What I learnt in Year 1.

I made a hand puppet.

I joined pre-cut fabric shapes with holes provided using a running stitch.

I was shown how to thread a needle and I had a go.

I decorated using fabric pens.

I glued on decorations such as sequins, beads, googly eyes and ribbons.

What I will know by the end of the unit:

How to draw around a given template.

How to cut out simple shapes from felt.

How to join fabrics by using running stitch and over sewing.

How to thread a needle and be more confident doing this on my own.

How to decorate using fabric pens.

How to glue on decorations such as sequins, beads and ribbons.

Vocabulary:

Template: A shape drawn to exact shape and size to assist in cutting out.

Applique: To attach a decorative fabric item onto another piece of fabric by gluing and/or sewing.

Design: To generate, develop and communicate ideas for a product.

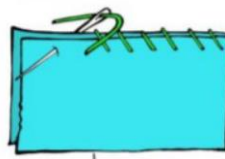
Textile: A type of cloth or woven fabric.

Aesthetic: The look of the product.
