

**Subject:** Design and Technology    **Topic:** Textiles – a purse    **Year Group:** 4

**Prior Learning:** In Year 3 I used simple provided patterns as a template to draw around and cut different fabrics. I joined fabrics using running stitch, over sewing and backstitch. I threaded a needle using a large eye. I added applique decorations using running stitch. I made a cushion.

**What I will know/be able to do by the end of the unit:**

- Draw own pattern as a template to draw around and cut a range of fabrics.
- Join fabrics using over sewing, backstitch and blanket stitch.
- Confidently thread a needle using a smaller eye.
- Add applique decorations using over sewing and running stitch.

**Design Brief:** To design and make a purse.

**Aesthetic Considerations:** TBC for example: appealing to specified user

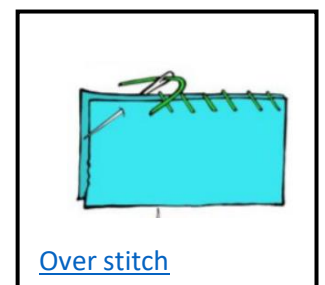
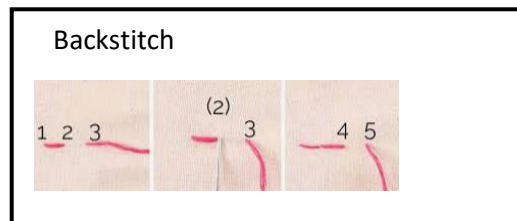

**Vocabulary:**

**Template:** A shape drawn to exact shape and size to assist in cutting out.

**Applique:** To attach a decorative fabric item onto another piece of fabric by gluing and/or sewing.

**Design:** To generate, develop and communicate ideas for a product.

**Textile:** A type of cloth or woven fabric.

**Aesthetic:** The look of the product.

**Eye of a needle:** The narrow opening at one end of the needle to place thread through
