Enrichment is a vital part of our commitment to developing happy, confident and well-rounded children. Our enrichment programme runs **from EYFS to Year 6** and is carefully designed to be **inclusive, progressive and meaningful**, offering pupils rich opportunities to explore interests, develop talents and deepen their understanding of the world.

Across the school, pupils take part in a range of **whole-school events** that bring the community together and build shared experiences, such as **World Book Day, Michael Morpurgo Day, Singing Choir events, TT Rockstars Day and Prayer Spaces**. These experiences are revisited and deepened as children move through the school, allowing understanding, participation and leadership to grow over time.

In addition, enrichment is strengthened through:

Termly themed days and weeks (including Arts Week, STEM Week, Book Week and Careers Week), which broaden horizons and provide meaningful curriculum links

Charity partnerships, supporting pupils to develop compassion, social responsibility and community awareness through events such as Harvest, Red Nose Day, Children in Need and church missions

Celebration events, including Values Awards which recognise achievement, character and creativity as well as our school values.

A wide and inclusive **clubs programme** (sports, arts, choir, gardening, comic club, chess club etc), enabling pupils to discover new interests and build confidence outside the classroom

Opportunities for **pupil voice and leadership**, with surveys, councils and roles ensuring children help shape school life and enrichment provision

Together, these experiences build progressively across each phase of the school, strengthening pupils' **character, skills, aspirations and sense of belonging**, and making a significant contribution to their personal development.
