## Big question: What kind of world did Jesus want?

### I should already:

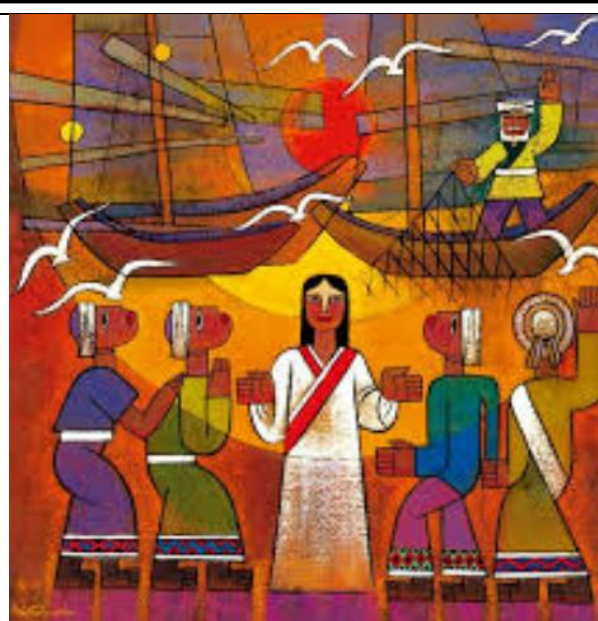
- Know that Christians believe Jesus brings good news to everybody.
- Know a story about how Jesus is a friend to everyone (the good news)
- Know a story about how Jesus forgives (good news)
- Give examples of how Christians follow these teachings.
- Know ways Christians put these beliefs into practice.

### Vocabulary:

<b>Gospel</b>	Message of love to all and that Jesus is God incarnate
<b>Clergy</b>	Part of the body of the church who have been ordained
<b>Love</b>	A fruit of the spirit and central to the Gospel being spread
<b>Becoming ordained</b>	A formal ceremony, often involving prayer, the laying on of hands, and the granting of authority by the church hierarchy
<b>Samaritan</b>	A charitable or helpful person
<b>Fisher of people</b>	Those who are called by Jesus to share the Gospel and spread the word of God

### By the end of the unit I will:

- Know the story of the calling of the first disciples.
- Understand what it means to Christians to be a 'fisher of people'.
- Know what the gospel means to Christians today and how it impacts their actions.
- Know what the clergy is and how they follow the teachings of Jesus.
- Know what love means (a fruit of the spirit) and how it impacts what Christians do.
