- Know what is the same and what is different about the way Christians practice their faith now and in the past.

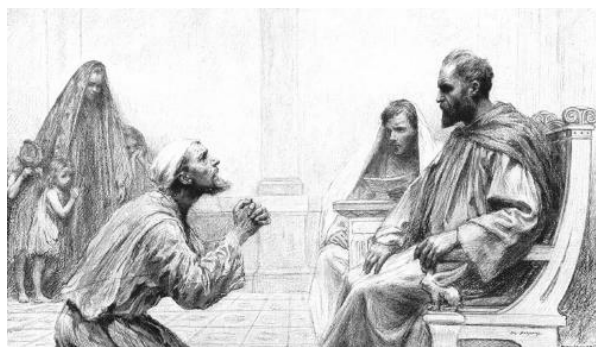
Vocabulary:

kingdom	The spiritual reign or authority of God
parable	A simple story used by Jesus to illustrate a moral or spiritual lesson
interpretation	Understanding or explaining the meaning of something
worship	Show reverence or adoration for a deity (God)
Community	People living together or sharing the same characteristics, ideas or interests
Utopia	An imagined place where everything is perfect

- Know clearly what the concept of 'The Kingdom of God' means to Christians.
- Know that the interpretations of Bible texts can vary.
- Know that belief in the Kingdom of God informs how Christian's worship.
- Know that belief in the Kingdom of God informs how Christian's act in servicing to the communality.
