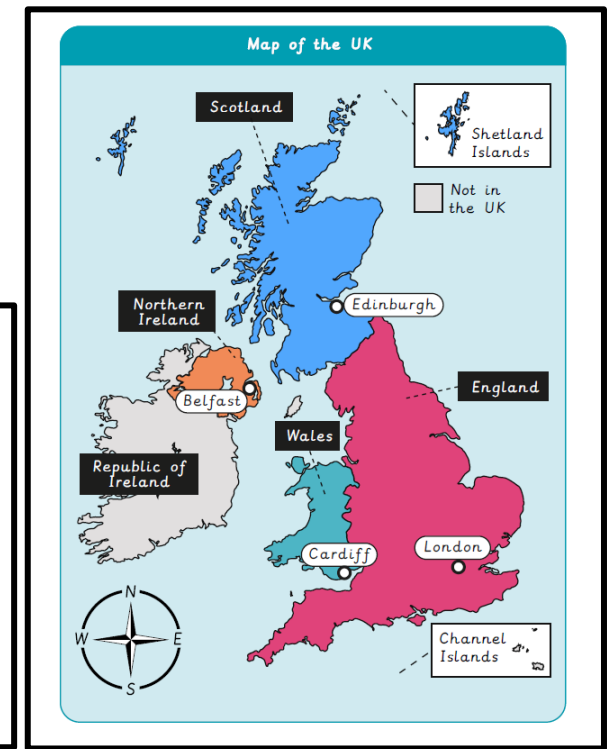
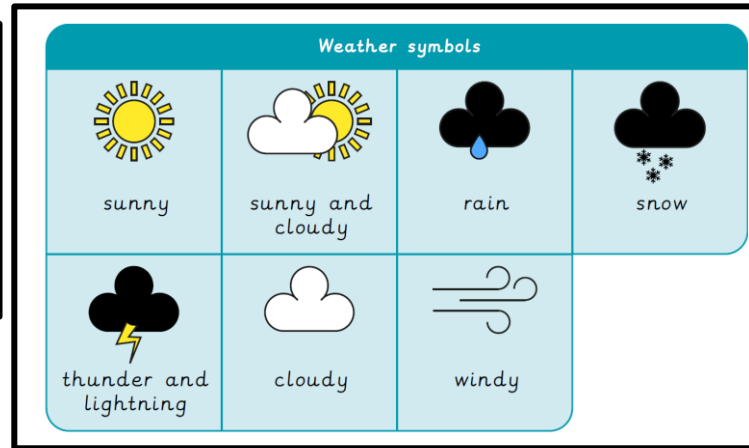
## What is the weather like in the UK?

<b>atlas</b>	A book of maps.
<b>capital city</b>	A city where the country's government is located.
<b>climate</b>	The long-term weather conditions in a specific region.
<b>compass</b>	An instrument with a pointer showing the direction of the magnetic north.
<b>continent</b>	A large land mass.
<b>country</b>	A land or nation with its own government.
<b>direction</b>	An imaginary line showing the way someone or something is moving.
<b>land</b>	The earth's surface not covered in water.
<b>locate</b>	Discover the position of something.
<b>location</b>	A particular place or position.
<b>map</b>	A picture of a place, drawn from above.
<b>rain gauge</b>	An instrument that measures the volume of rain in a given amount of time.
<b>season</b>	One of four parts of a year marked by the weather conditions.
<b>temperature</b>	A measure of how hot or cold something or somewhere is.
<b>thermometer</b>	An instrument for measuring wind.
<b>weather</b>	The short-term conditions in a particular place.
<b>weather vane</b>	An instrument which shows the direction of the wind.
